Students wishing to participate in CCP should attend one of these meetings with a parent/guardian before applying for admission. Students and parents who do not attend one of the above meetings must arrange a separate CCP counseling session with their school counselor. CCP is available to students in grades 7-12. Students and parents must sign A Letter of Intent to Participate in CCP and return it to the school counselor by April 1, 2016 in order for students to take CCP classes at colleges or at high schools during the 2016-2017 school year. Forms will be available at all district meetings.

All meetings will feature representatives from OSU, CSCC and other participating colleges.

Any student who is even considering taking CCP courses next year should attend one of these meetings and return a signed Letter of Intent by APRIL 1.
